Question: *It seems things are getting worse in our society all the time, what will be the end of it all?*

Answer: Perhaps I can answer this with an article I came across which makes many good points: The prophet Hosea wrote, "They sow the wind, and reap the whirlwind" (Hosea 8:7). The apostle Paul wrote, "...for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap" (Galatians 6:7). The law of the harvest applies not only to individual lives and families, but to entire nations. America is now reaping what she has sown. It is a ghastly harvest!

For well over one hundred years, scientists and educators have been sowing evolution. We now have an entire adult generation that has been taught the evolutionary philosophy of life. Now we are reaping the whirlwind! You see, if man is nothing more than an "animal," it cannot be morally wrong to kill animals. We now have five thousand abortions a day in this country.
