Bible Questions and Answers

Question: Why can't I understand the King James Bible? What is a good way to study for understanding?

Answer: There are only so many good translations out there. The King James is one of the best, but some people get hung up on the "thee and thou" type stuff. You can just get used to it for the sake of having a good translation (much better than the New International Version, for example) or you could get a New King James Version. Whatever you decide to do, remember that the Scriptures can't be "dumbed down." There are just some things that are pretty deep and harder to understand, as Peter says of Paul's writings in 2 Peter 3:16b – "...are some things hard to be understood, which they that are unlearned and unstable wrest, as they do also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction." To keep from misusing the Scriptures as some did, we must get the meaning of the verses surrounding the one we are studying, know who is speaking, to whom, and the occasion of the writing. The Bible was meant for the common man and can be understood with good effort
