## Bible Question and Answer

**Question:** Once I was saved, will I always be saved?

**Answer:** No, not necessarily. It is a popular doctrine among some that "once saved always saved," but it will not hold up to the Scriptures. "And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not" (Galatians 6:9). That last phrase with the "if" is very important. What "if" we don't continue doing well, but rather rebel against God? Will God continue to call us saved anyway? No He will not. There were some at Galatia who had fallen from grace (Gal. 5:4), and there are many people now who have not remained true to the calling of God. We should all take heed to the parable of Jesus about the Vine and the branches, let us do all we can to remain on the Vine by the grace of God! "I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman. 2Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit... If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned. 7If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you." (John 15:1,2,6,7)
