Righteous Judgment

Judge – one who has skill to decide on anything, a critic...to act as a judge; to pass sentence; to form an opinion; to estimate...to hear and determine; to examine into and decide; to try; to esteem.

Condemn – to pronounce to be wrong; to censure; to sentence.

Good Judgments

Righteous – based on all evidence that must be considered from reliable sources.
