- 1) Begin with infancy to give the child everything he wants. In this way he will grow up to believe the world owes him a living.
- 2) When he picks up bad words, laugh at him. This will encourage him to pick up “cuter” things later.
- 3) Never give him any spiritual training. Wait until he is 21 and let him decide for himself.
- 4) Avoid use of the word “wrong.” It may develop a guilt complex.
- 5) Pick up everything he leaves lying around. Do everything for him so he can learn to throw all responsibility onto others later in life.
- 6) Let him read any printed matter he can get his hands on. Make sure he washes his hands before eating but let his mind feast on garbage.
- 7) Quarrel frequently in the presence of your children. In this way they will not be too shocked when the home is broken up later.
- 8) Never let the child earn any of his spending money. Why should he have things as tough as YOU had them.
- 9) Satisfy his every craving for food, drink, and comfort. Denial may lead to harmful frustration.
- 10) Always take his part against neighbors, teachers, etc. After all, they are just pre-ju-dice against him.
- 11) When he gets into real trouble, apologize for yourself by saying, “I could never do anything with him.”
- 12) Prepare for a life of grief. You are apt to have it with this child.
