3. Be as consistent as you can in your church attendance. Remember that the Lord wants you to be at the assembly (Hebrews 10:25) If I go out and invite people in your family to come to church, I sometimes mention how happy you would be if you saw them at church. Can you imagine our embarrassment if they were to come and not find their family at church! Perhaps the best encouragement we can give to others is to let them see us at church!

Verses in preparation for the Lord's Supper: **Exodus 12:11b-13**
“...it is the LORD'S passover. ¹²For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I *am* the LORD. ¹³And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye *are*: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt **1 Corinthians 5:7 - 8** ⁷Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us: ⁸Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened *bread* of sincerity and truth.
