WORSHIPPING WITH HEART

Later, Queen Candace of Ethiopia’s officer, after having learned of Jesus having believed, having confessed Him, and having been baptized into Him, (Acts 8:35-38; Gal. 3:27), “went on his way rejoicing” (Acts 8:39). His life having been changed forever, having gained an Advocate before God, and a propitiation for sins (1 Jn, 2:1-2), joy flooded into his heart as he went home a redeemed individual.

Later still, the apostle Peter would encourage soon-suffering Christians by reminding them of that which animated their worship and service to Christ. “Whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see him not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory” (1 Pet. 1:8). Christians then and now, absent from the Lord (2 Cor. 5:6), love Him, and rejoice with joy unspeakable in anticipation of seeing Him one day! This anticipation of being present with the King furnishes our spirits with joy in taking of the Lord’s Supper (1 Cor. 10:16), in singing (Jas. 5:13), in praying (Rom 12:12), in giving (2 Cor 9:7), and in hearing the proclamation of God’s Word (Acts 2:4; Acts 13:48): **joy in worship.**
