Question: Does the Bible say anything about Dinosaurs?

Answer: Maybe. It is hard to be definite, but what sounds like a dinosaur (that is, some kind of extinct reptile or other animal) is found in Job 40:15 - – “¹⁵Behold now behemoth, which I made with thee; he eateth grass as an ox. ¹⁶Lo now, his strength *is* in his loins, and his force *is* in the navel of his belly. ¹⁷He moveth his tail like a cedar: the sinews of his stones are wrapped together. ¹⁸His bones *are as* strong pieces of brass; his bones *are* like bars of iron. ¹⁹He *is* the chief of the ways of God: he that made him can make his sword to approach *unto him*. ²⁰Surely the mountains bring him forth food, where all the beasts of the field play. ²¹He lieth under the shady trees, in the covert of the reed, and fens. ²²The shady trees cover him *with* their shadow; the willows of the brook compass him about. ²³Behold, he drinketh up a river, *and* hasteth not: he trusteth that he can draw up Jordan into his mouth” and in Job 41:1, which speaks of “leviathan.” These animals don’t appear to fit any modern mammalian descriptions, but they do fit the description of a dinosaur. Is that what they were? I don’t know. The book of Job is very old, and there is plenty of evidence for saying that man and dinosaur once lived together, but I don’t think it’s an issue you can learn much about so I wouldn’t spend **too** much time on it.

One big point to make about this whole issue is to look at all books and sources of information with both an open mind and a healthy skepticism. The Bible has nothing to fear from true science, so let the science take you where it will. On the other hand, many “scientists” have an agenda and none should be trusted just because they are “scientists.” Demand evidence. If they say X rock is Y no. of years old, don’t believe it just because they said so. They didn’t live back then, so they don’t know. The constant assertions of evolutionists that dinosaurs all died out long before man came are just false and unfounded. They just blindly believe that that is the way it was. Sometimes I think those “scientists” would say the moon is made of cheese if the Bible said it wasn’t – just to show spite.
