Bible Questions and Answers:

Question: What is the church of Christ? Tell me about the Mt. Gilead church of Christ.

Christ’s church is his body (Eph. 1:21-23). Since that passage is obviously not referring to His physical body, the church is his spiritual body. But the Bible says “Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular.” (I Corinthians 12:27).

Therefore, we are talking about people when we say Christ’s spiritual body, but how many people? All Christian people! Paul told the saints at Corinth that they were the body of Christ, the church! Now, obviously Christ’s body or church at one place needs to be distinguished from those who meet and worship at another place. That is where we get the place-names from, like Mt. Gilead church of Christ. The name simply means the Lord’s church at Mount Gilead. The same thing is done in Revelation 2 & 3 when it mentions the Lord’s church in various locations. The Mount Gilead church of Christ is a scripturally organized group of New Testament Christians. Come back and visit us again!
