Evangelistic Report. I recently had a detailed conversation with Stephen Foster from Harlan Co., KY. He is trying to complete a building and get a mainstream congregation started in this county.



As you can see from the box on the map, this county is located just north of where TN, KY, and Virginia meet. The area is highly Pentecostal with respect to religion, and I

understand that it is somewhat economically depressed. They are right now completing some things on the building that by and large have to do with outside projects to fulfill state regulations and so

forth. When they are all done, they will have a Meeting with all of the congregations supporting the work especially invited. I believe this work will make slow but sure progress in that area. We are presently sending \$500/month to get this work going.

On another front, the Youth for Truth camp at Tennessee Bible College went very well this past week. They had a record number of campers and Tyler and others conducted a Vacation Bible School lesson on the last night at camp. If any of our young people are interested in this camp, just ask Tyler about the format and the fun and make plans to be there in 2009!
