Do's and Don'ts for Sunday

- Don't be in a hurry to leave. Hurry to worship; do not hurry to finish it. Sunday is the Lord's Day! He is worth our time.
- Do arrive with a smile. "I was glad when they said unto me, let us go into the house of the Lord." (Psa 122:1)
- Don't be cliquish! Enlarge the circle of those you embrace and befriend. Encourage your children to do the same.
- Do try to bring a guest. Over 90% of all Christians visited at least one assembly before they were converted to Christ.
- Do expect to hear babies crying.
- Do expect to be blessed.
