Gospel Meeting: There will be a meeting starting today at Berea going through the 12th. Evening services will be at 7pm for the weekday services. I will be in a meeting at the Milestown church of Christ in Clay Co. on the 17th and 18th. I will teach in a “all day” VBS at 10am on the 22nd at the Northwest church of Christ.

Question: I want to know if the Trinity, God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit, are three different beings with equal power, or the same being with different titles. Also, are there any references to this in the King James Version?

Answer: Let’s deal with this from the last question and go back. There is no reference at all in the KJV, or any reliable translation, to the word “Trinity.” However, there is reference to the “Godhead” – Acts 17:29; Rom. 1:20 & Col. 2:9. The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are not mere titles, so they are not just the same being with different titles. It is difficult to use the word “being” or use other such words in which we speak of a creature. The Creator, God, is different from all of us so understanding Him as well as we would like is simply beyond us here and now. Let me say this: As you read Acts 17 and other places you understand some of the “nature” of God. There is one God. That is, there is one all-knowing, all-powerful, all-loving Creator. There are three personalities, or persons, who are this Creator. They have this nature. They are the Godhead, or Trinity, if you will. It’s not like the Father created the world, but not the Son. Their work is in concert with one another. Consider a room with several florescent lights. The light is the same. By the time it reaches our body, we cannot distinguish it. Yet we know that there are several bulbs up there. I encourage you to study passages like Acts 17 and Genesis 1 that explain the power and purpose of God revealed to us through his creation, and then study the Bible to learn exactly what He wants from us in all things.

What Must I do to be saved?

- **Hear the Gospel - Acts 15:7**
- **Believe the Gospel - Mark 16:15,16**
- **Repent of Sins - Acts 17:30**
- **Confess Christ - Rom. 10:9,10**
- **Be Baptized for the Forgiveness of Sins - Acts 2:38**

Then, as a Christian we must:

- **LIVE FAITHFUL UNTO DEATH - REV. 2:10**
