4. You must not bow to bitterness. **"Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice" (Eph. 4:31).**
5. You must not allow one wrong to become the cause of another. **<sup>14</sup>For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: <sup>15</sup>But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses. Matthew 6:14-15(KJV)**
6. What you do is more important than how you feel. **Romans 12:20 says, "But if your enemy is hungry, feed him, and if he is thirsty, give him a drink.."**
7. You are still the bigger debtor **(Matthew 18:21-35).**
