Baptism

Introduction

- Subject is not talked about as much as it used to be. Why?
- Some don't want to think about those who haven't been baptized.
- Some are too busy talking about other things they think are more practical.
- You can be baptized quickly – Acts 2.
- Your baptism must be sincere.

Body

- The basics.
 - Acts 8, Romans 6 – baptism is immersion.
 - Baptism follows in a natural order. There are many examples of the “steps” of salvation. An example is Cornelius' house: They repented unto life (Acts 11:18), Why would they repent without belief? They were baptized into Christ (Gal. 3:26-27).
- What is baptism for?
 - God can name His own terms.
 - Water does nothing of itself.
 - It is to get into Christ.
